What is different?



- Report Cards/Progress Reports
 - You will **NOT** get a report card each 9 weeks as a Virtual Student. Apex shows you an updated progress report every day, so that is how you will monitor your grades.
 - You **WILL** get a report card at the end of the semester with your final grade from your classes. This is the only time you will see your grades in Infinite Campus
- Office Hours for Teachers
 - Teachers are only available during their designated block, so in some cases it may take them until the following day to get back to you.

Helpful Tips

 - Course Name you are emailing about (ex: 9th Grade Literature), Unit you are working on (ex: Literary Elements), Lesson you are working on (Lesson 1)
 - **This information will be in a numerical format for you to email easily to your teacher**
